Call for Posters

The International Health Workforce Collaborative offers poster viewing sessions as an opportunity to share and discuss current workforce-related research activities. These sessions will feature workforce research posters related to the conference theme: "Scaling up Health Workforce Innovations to Promote Equity, Diversity and Inclusion". To facilitate integration of poster presentations into the conference program, dedicated plenary sessions will allow authors to provide three-minute presentations to highlight key messages that can be drawn from their poster. ***The deadline to submit an abstract is Tuesday, May 21, 2019.***

Abstract Submission Procedures

To apply, please submit a 500 word poster(s) abstract in Word format to info@hr-rhs.ca. All abstract submissions must include:

1. ***Principal/Presenting author(s):*** given name, surname, affiliation(s), and email address.
 2. ***Co-Author(s) (if applicable):*** given name, surname and affiliation(s)
 3. ***Title:*** Provide a succinct title for your poster
 4. ***Background (Max 75 words):*** Provide the context and reason for undertaking this research
 5. ***Objectives (Max 50 words):*** What are the objectives or expected outcome(s) of your research
 6. ***Methodology (Max 100 words):*** Describe the methods/approach used to undertake your research
 7. ***Findings (Max 100 words):*** Describe your research findings, impact or outcomes of your research
 8. ***Conclusions (Max 50 words):*** Describe the conclusions that can be drawn from your research
 9. ***Three Take Home Messages/Policy Implications (Max 75 words):*** Please provide three take-home messages from your abstract that may be of interest to researchers and/or knowledge users
 10. ***Relevance of the topic to the conference theme (Max 50 words):*** Please describe how your poster relates to the conference theme "Scaling up Health Workforce Innovations to Promote Equity, Diversity and Inclusion"
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All abstract submissions will be reviewed by a subcommittee of the IHWC Conference Global Planning Committee to ensure that it is relevant to the conference theme. You will be notified whether the poster has been accepted by June 14, 2019. Once accepted, you are asked to prepare the poster(s) in accordance with the guidelines detailed below. The highest ranked poster from each country will be selected by the Global Planning Subcommittee and announced during the conference.

Guidelines for Posters

If selected, presenters will be provided with additional details regarding poster dimensions. Posters should include: title, authors, affiliation, contact information, background, objectives, methodology, findings, conclusions, take home messages, and a statement outlining how the project explicitly considers equity, diversity and inclusion.

All final posters are to be submitted in PDF for upload onto the IHWC website. Contact information should be provided in the body of the poster. Posters with dense text are discouraged since they tend to be difficult to read. Poster presenters are responsible for bringing their posters to the IHWC event in Ottawa and handing them over at registration to be displayed.

Additional Details

If your abstract is accepted, you and your co-presenter(s) (if applicable) are:

- expected to register and present at the conference
- responsible for paying all expenses associated with presenting and attending the Conference (e.g. preparation of the poster, registration fee, travel, hotel, etc.)
